Shigella

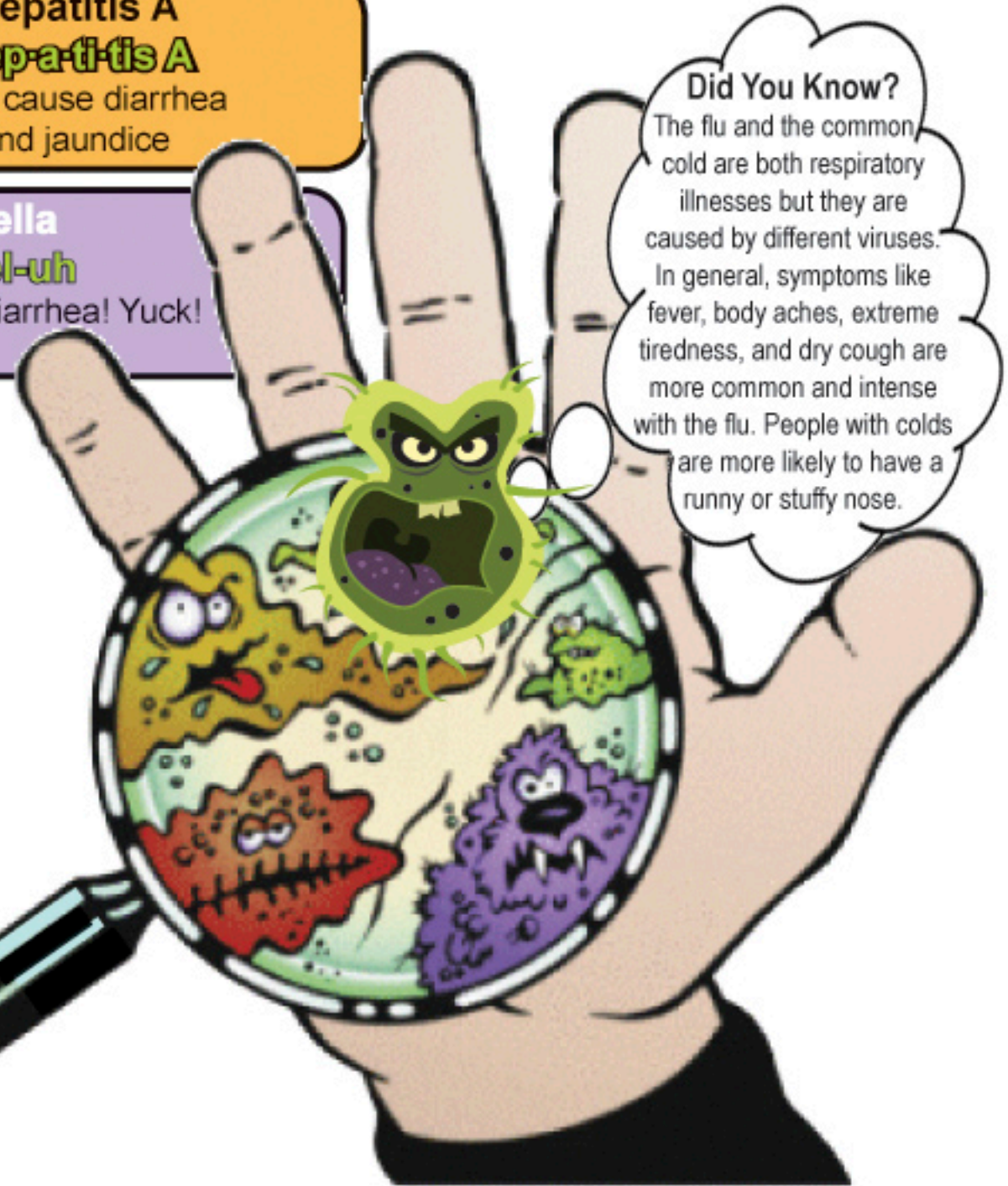
shi-gel-uh
